



Terms and Conditions for the Wonder of Science Program

UQ and the School agree to the following terms in the delivery of the Wonder of Science Program:

UQ Responsibilities

- UQ is responsible for:
 - o Developing the content in the Wonder of Science Program;
 - o Creating all promotional materials for the Wonder of Science Program;
 - o Selecting the Wonder of Science Program Ambassadors who will deliver the Wonder of Science Program in the School;
 - o Ensuring all Wonder of Science Ambassadors have a current 'Working with Children' check and a Police Clearance;
 - o Preparing and presenting the one-day professional learning for teachers: 'STEM Inquiry – the Wonder of Science Approach at the School';
 - o Providing the School with the Wonder of Science challenge tasks, teacher unit overview and criteria sheets; and
 - o Preparing and facilitating two Ambassador-led lessons and providing the corresponding educational materials to the School.

School Responsibilities

- The School is responsible for:
 - o Approving the content in the Wonder of Science Program as provided by UQ prior to delivery to the School;
 - o Accepting and orientating as necessary the Wonder of Science Ambassadors at the School;
 - o Providing the Wonder of Science Ambassadors with a suitable venue for both the School students and performance of the Wonder of Science Program;
 - o Providing a safe working environment for the Wonder of Science Ambassadors;
 - o Ensuring the safe supervision of the students during the Wonder of Science Program;
 - o Providing all necessary personal protective equipment and any other necessary materials for students participating in the Wonder of Science Program;
 - o Ensuring the equipment and materials provided by the School to the Wonder of Science Ambassadors comply with all relevant workplace health and safety laws;
 - o Promoting the Wonder of Science Program to students, teachers and the wider School community; and
 - o Participating in any necessary UQ evaluation process as requested.

Risk

UQ reserves the right to refuse to deliver the Wonder of Science Program if in its reasonable opinion there may be a risk to the safety of any member of the audience or participants in the Wonder of Science Program or the Wonder of Science Ambassadors.

UQ is not responsible for injury to students or teachers or damage to property which may occur during the course of the Wonder of Science Program.
